

Call for Papers

“10th Nordic Summer Symposium in Macroeconomics”

Ebeltoft, Denmark, August 10-13, 2016

Deadline for Submission: April 29, 2016



OBJECTIVE

The symposium is an academic research conference in the area of macroeconomics. It is primarily aimed at promoting frontier contributions by junior macroeconomic researchers. A connection to the Nordic countries is an advantage but not a prerequisite. The symposium allows the junior researchers to present and discuss their research and to receive advice and constructive criticism from more senior macroeconomic scholars.

TOPICS

Papers on all topics broadly associated with macroeconomics are welcome including "standard" macroeconomic analysis (real and monetary business cycles, labor markets, growth etc.) and issues such as public finance, human capital accumulation, firm dynamics, asset pricing, heterogeneous agents, income distribution, credit markets and political economy.

PRESENTATION FORMAT

35 minutes presentation, 15 minutes discussion and 10 minutes general discussion for each paper.

The Conference Venue is Hotel Ebeltoft Strand, <http://ebeltoftstrand.dk/en>, located in Ebeltoft, Denmark. Ebeltoft is a small town on the East Coast of Jutland known for its historical city centre with cobble-stoned streets and half-timbered houses. It hosts Fregatten Jylland, one of the best preserved wooden warships in the world, a glass museum, it has a charming marina and many beaches in the vicinity of the city. It is located 50km north of Aarhus, and only 15km from Aarhus Airport and can be reached easily by bus from either.

WHO SHOULD APPLY

The conference aims at promoting and facilitating the work of junior researchers. Researchers with an interest in or connection to the Nordic countries (Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden) are particularly appreciated but the call is open to all junior applicants. Junior refers to those about to graduate from a PhD program, post-doctoral students, assistant professors, researchers in policy institutions, and recently tenured senior professors.
