

In September 2005, Nigeria negotiated US\$19billion in debt relief from the Paris Club group of creditors. This amounts to roughly US\$750million in savings of Federal Government debt servicing per annum.

The President, Chief Olusegun Obasanjo, directed that these savings be directed to pro-poor Millennium Development Goals-related projects and programs.

This scrapbook of photos gives an overview of how debt relief was spent for the betterment of the people of Nigeria ...

The 2006 Federal Budget Appropriation allocated approximately N100billion in debt relief gains. The funds were distributed as follows:

- The Health sector received N21,288,000,000
- The Education sector received N18,221,707,736
- The Water sector received N19,015,599,154
- The Power sector received N16,961,839,096
- The Works sector received N9,855,000,000
- The Agriculture sector received N9,400,000,000
- Ministry of Environment received N1,485,000,000
- Ministry of Women Affairs received N1,000,000
- Ministry of Youth received N990,000,000
- Ministry of Housing received N495,000,000

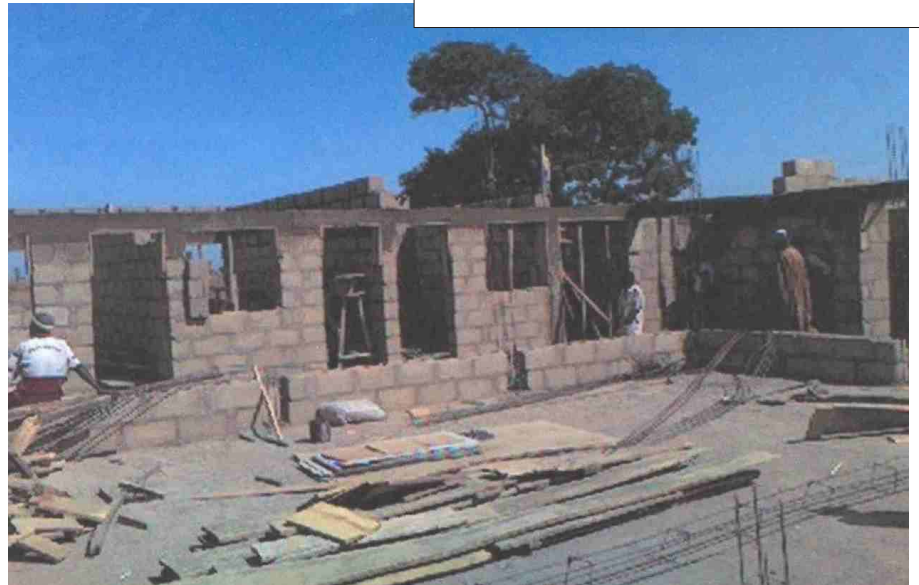

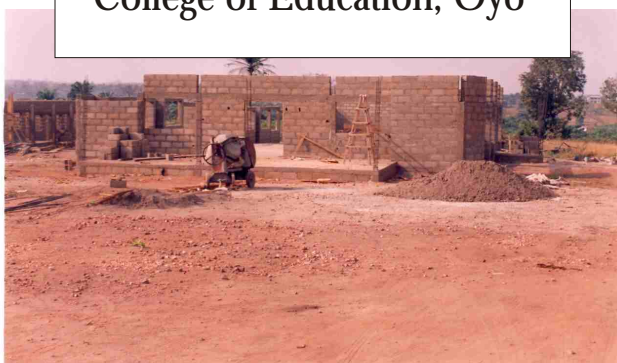

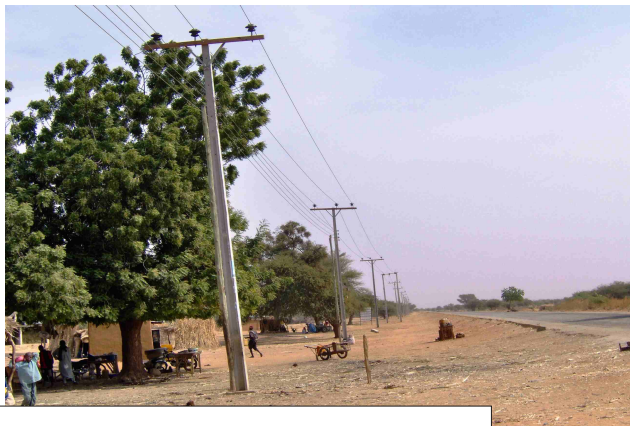

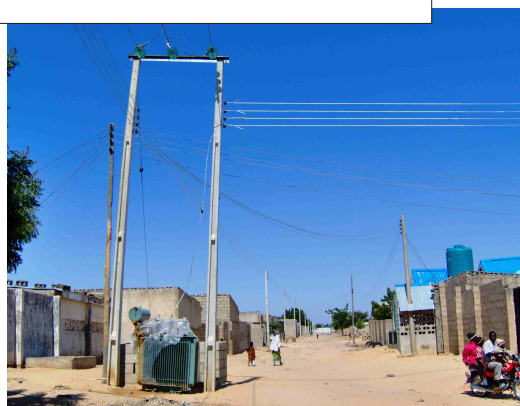

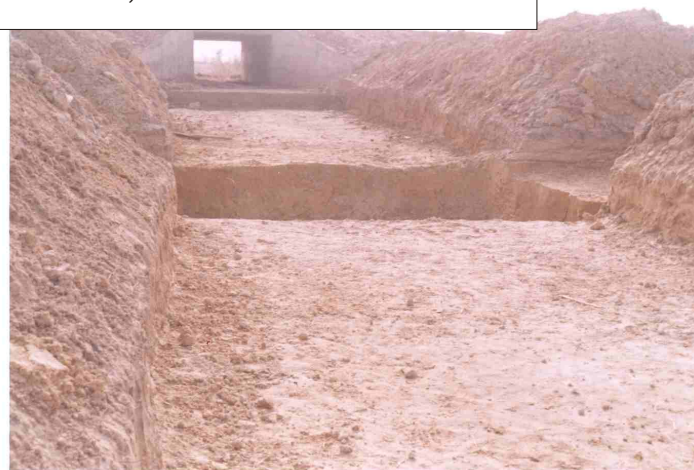

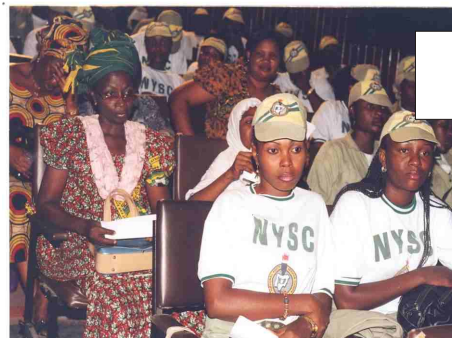

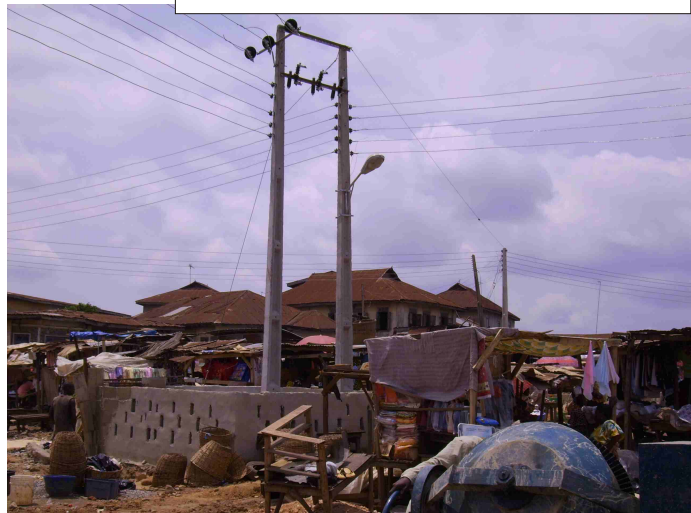
